Why

Within 30 days of publication, each book is registered with the US Copyright Office and two "fair copies" sent to the Library of Congress. Several months later, the certificate comes in the mail. While it's not likely you will be registering new books under my pseudonyms, you still need to know the registration numbers in case my work is ever plagiarized or its copyright otherwise infringed. He who registers first tends to win in a lawsuit. Certificates can be found here:
